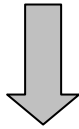


# Annual School Report 2009

## BROAD STRATEGIC GOAL

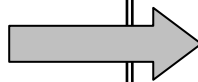
Christ the King School aims to operate out of a strong, clear mission.

## Achievements for 2008

PD in 2009 aligned with accreditation requirements to teach in a catholic school and teach RE in a Catholic school as well as incorporating accreditation with Queensland College of Teachers

Staff led prayer at Staff Meetings and Admin and Students led prayer at Assemblies and other formal occasions.

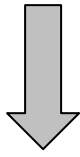
We celebrated important events including NAIDOC Day and Sorry Day.

Professional development was attended on teaching literacy and embedding Technology in lesson planning

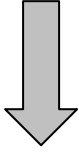
Teaching staff continued to develop criteria sheets for class assessment use.

### Achievements for 2009

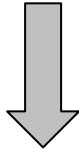
Students' special needs have been identified and where possible programs altered to assist the students to access the curriculum.

## BROAD STRATEGIC GOAL

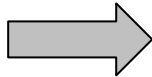
Christ the King School aims to support staff.

Professional learning opportunities for staff were collaboratively planned, regularly evaluated and aligned to the school strategic renewal plan.

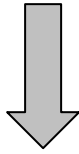
Staff professional learning was strongly linked to the improvement of student learning outcomes.

## BROAD STRATEGIC GOAL

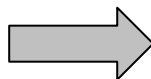
Christ the King School aims to build and strengthen partnerships and relationships.

### Achievements for 2009

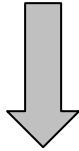
The school board engaged parents in policy development and school renewal processes. The Anaphylaxis and the Bullying and Harassment policies were established

### Achievements for 2009

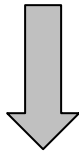
School technology plans included access to hardware, software, training and support for staff and students was implemented.

## BROAD STRATEGIC GOAL

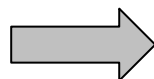
Christ the King School aims to Provide Quality Resources to support student learning.

4. Develop and budget for a thorough and systematic maintenance plan.



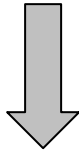
### Achievements for 2009
